Hypertension Case Finding

- Work required to understand the reasons behind low uptake of ABPM consultations.
- Nationally 3.5% of consultations are for ABPM, and it is believed that up to 34% of
 consultations should be eligible for follow up with ABPM. HNY has 5.90% ABPM
 consultations on average but need to review activity data to establish barriers to
 increasing ABPM consultations (see tables below)
 - Would like to hear feedback from pharmacies about the service and their experiences in order to showcase what is working well / share good practice.
