 Bank holidays and open normal hours on all other days.
- Pharmacies who give notice of being open on Public and Bank holidays will have this information passed on to relevant organisations including Places, NHS111 and local newspapers
- NHS Humber and North Yorkshire ICB has agreed a rota covering these bank holidays and those contractors will be required to open as directed
