C-Card</li> <li>9. Pregnancy Testing</li> <li>10. provision of Chlamydia test kits</li> <li>11. Provision of condoms with PCS EHC</li> </ol> <p>Intention to expand range of STI kits provide through pharmacies, mechanism under discussion at present.</p> <p>PO platforms to rebuild to support service changes. Quote for work submitted to NELC for approval. Also discussing provision of LARC to replace EHC.</p> <p>Current local ACT/EHC service will continue whilst changes to spec are implemented. Advised pharmacies to offer local service where client will benefit from additional provision of Condoms / chlamydia kits. **MEDICATION SHORTAGES**

Medication shortages service analysis:

- a. Data up to end of October has been collated; initial findings in my preliminary report.
- b. Survey created and shared with pharmacies.
- c. Survey created and shared with GP practices (Andre?).

To explore:

- i. Usefulness / ease of use.
- ii. Potential time saved in the pharmacy and in GP practice.
- iii. Popularity and acceptance by pharmacies and GP practices.
- iv. Effectiveness.
- v. Feasibility of expansion to larger area.

Once the surveys are received an analysis of the platform will be shared to determine its value and whether expansion is warranted.
